- **Net Neutrality**
 - Reinstate Net Neutrality rules
 - Enact legislation to make Net Neutrality the law

- **Privacy**
 - Update the Privacy Act
 - Privacy Act was passed in 1974, a lot has changed since then
 - HIPPA has not been effective, as every provider requires that you waive your privacy rights
 - Need to add Internet Privacy provisions
 - Internet regulations should require Transparency
 - Individuals have the right to know what corporations know about them
 - Should be easy to access and free to access
 - Internet regulations should require Revocability
 - If an individual wants to revoke their permissions, the collecting company should be required to delete any information which has a personal identifier, or the ability to link to the individual

- **Political Activity on the Internet**
 - If an Internet site or application is monetized, they accept a responsibility to exercise editorial responsibility
 - Must be responsible to ensure information is true
 - Must clearly label what is sponsored advertising, not user content
 - Internet ads should follow the same laws as other media formats
 - Paid political ads must identify who is paying for them
 - No U.S. political ads can be paid for by foreign persons, corporations, or governments

- **Ownership**
 - Individuals should have ownership rights to any information that another person or company collects on them
 - No corporation should own your DNA and market it for profit without your permission
 - You should have as much ownership of your health records as the doctor
