



- Less testing, more teaching
 - Multiple choice tests are not the best way to measure performance
 - Should not be forced to “teach to the test”
 - America’s strength is creativity, not rote memorization
 - Need to include more measures of success
 - Should include Vo-Tech programs as a portion of evaluation
 - Need to teach more than Reading, Writing and Arithmetic
 - Students who study Music do better in Math
 - Students who study Art do better in English
 - Students who do PE can concentrate better in all other classes
 - Need to recognize and accommodate Special Learners
 - Different children learn in different ways – Need to design education plans to teach children in the way they learn best
 - Education should be focused on the abilities of the student – Students who need life skills training should not be distracted by tasks they cannot perform
